Internet survey on life and work: 2011 survey, usage regulations

Created on January 29, 2018

(Purpose)

Article 1

To determine necessary matters involving the use of "the Internet survey on life and work: 2011 survey" (hereinafter referred to as "data"), carried out by the Institute of Economic Research, Hitotsubashi University (hereinafter referred to as the "Institute").

(Scope of users)
Article 2
People in the following categories will be eligible to use these data:
(1) Those carrying out academic or survey research
(2) Others who have received specific authorization from the Director of the Institute of Economic Research, Hitotsubashi University.

(Application for use) Article 3 Anyone who wishes to use these data must apply to the Director of the Institute of Economic Research, Hitotsubashi University for approval, using the application form provided.

(Approval of use) Article 4 The Director will approve individual applications (see above) if and when he/she deems it appropriate.

(Period of use)

Article 5

(1) The period during which the user can use these data is, in principle, one year from the date of approval.

(2) In the event that a user needs access to the data beyond the one-year deadline, he or she must submit an application with a revised end date within the time limit; the consent of the Director must be obtained.

(Considerations that apply during the usage period)

Article 6

When using these data, the user must adhere to the terms of the written oath (Document 6), and ensure that all data are managed using the agreed usage place, storage place, and management method (Document 4), which were separately submitted.

(Cancellation of use, etc.)

Article 7

If a user violates the provisions of Article 6, the Director may cancel the approval and prevent any further use of the data.

(Disputes between users and third parties, disclaimers, etc.) Article 8

(1) If a dispute arises between the user and a third party with respect to the use of these data, neither the depositor nor the Institute will bear any responsibility.

(2) The depositor and the Institute will bear no responsibility for any damages that may accrue to users from the use of these data or for any damage caused by users to third parties.

(Inquiries)

Article 9

Inquiries about the individual data to be used, the survey method, and related issues must be made to the Institute, not directly to the depositor.

(Changes)

Article 10

The Institute may arbitrarily revise and expand these data. In that case, the expanded or revised data will be covered by every article in this set of regulations.

The Institute may change existing articles or add new ones whenever it deems this necessary, without giving prior notice to users.

(Others)

Article 11

In the event of any doubt or conflict about matters not stipulated in these regulation, or the interpretation of articles included in these regulations, users, depositors, and the Institute will settle the issue through consultation, in accordance with the principles of fidelity and integrity.
